
August 15: Feast of the DORMITION of our Lady the Most Holy MOTHER OF GOD, and of her ASSUMPTION

Transfer of the remains of the Holy MAXIMUS the Confessor

Maximus is remembered principally on January 21. The transfer of his remains from Lazia to Constantinople occurred after the Sixth Ecumenical Council, in the year 680.
