Saints of the Week

Today: Commemoration of our Holy Father PIMEN

8/28: Commemoration of our Holy Father MOSES THE ABYSSINIAN; our Father among the Saints AUGUSTINE, Bishop of Hippo and Doctor of the Universal Church

8/29: Feast of the Beheading of the Honorable and Glorious Prophet and Forerunner JOHN THE BAPTIST

A day of fasting. One of only two such feasts throughout the year.

John the Baptist ended his life in prison and died a martyr for the sake of the holy principles and God's commandments. His head is preserved in the church of St. Sylvester in Rome.

8/30: Commemoration of our Fathers among the Saints ALEXANDER, JOHN and PAUL THE LATTER, Archbishops of Constantinople

8/31: Deposition of the Honorable CINCTURE of our Most Holy Lady the MOTHER OF GOD, in Calcoprateia

The cincture of the Blessed Mother was said to have been found in the days of the Emperor Justinian (527-565). In the year 941, it was placed in a reliquary in Calcoprateia.

9/1: Beginning of the Indiction (the Ecclesiastical New Year);

Commemoration of our Holy Father SIMEON THE STYLITE;

Synaxis of the most holy Mother of God, venerated in her own icon of MIASENES; The Holy Martyr AEITHALAS, the FORTY HOLY WOMEN martyred with their instructor AMMON THE DEACON, the Three Brothers and the Just JOSHUA son of Nun

The Indiction is a cycle of fifteen years, which began in the year 312 AD, under Constantine the Great. In Constantinople, the Year of Indiction began originally on September 1.

9/2: Commemoration of the Holy Martyr MAMMAS; our Father among the Saints JOHN THE FASTER, Patriarch of Constantinople

Holy Mysteries

Mysteries of Christian Initiation: 1 month advance notice. Parents and Sponsors must be practicing Catholics and properly registered in a parish.

Mystery of Holy Crowning: 6 months advance notice. Required: One meeting with Fr. Rezkallah and participation in a marriage preparation program approved by the Catholic Church.

Mystery of Reconciliation: Before or after any service or by appointment

Mystery of Holy Unction: Available for those who are ill or anticipating an operation.

READING from the first epistle of St. Paul to the Corinthians

BRETHREN, I remind you of the Good News I preached to you, and which you received, and in which you stand, through which also you are being saved, if you hold fast to it as I

preached it to you — otherwise you would have believed in vain. For I delivered to you first of all what I had also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures, and that He appeared to Kephas, and after that, to the Twelve. Then He was seen by more than five hundred brethren at one time, many of whom are still with us, while some have fallen asleep. After that, He was seen by James, then by all the apostles, and last of all, as by one born out of due time, He was seen also by me. For I am the least of the apostles, and am not worthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted God's Church. But by God's grace, I am what I am, and His grace in me has not been fruitless — in fact, I have labored more than any of them, yet not I, but God's grace with me. Whether it be I or they (who speak), this is what we preach, and this you have believed.

At that time a certain young man came to Jesus and said, "Good Master, what good work shall I do to have eternal life?" He said to him, "Why do you call Me good? No one is good but God. But if you will enter into life, keep the commandments." He said to Him, "Which?" And Jesus answered, -'Thou shalt not kill, thou shalt not commit adultery, thou shalt not steal, thou shalt not bear false witness, honor thy father and mother, and, thou shalt love thy

neighbor as thyself." The young man said to Him, "All these I have kept; what is still lacking in me?" Jesus said to him, "If you will be perfect, go, sell what you have, and give to the poor, and you shall have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me." But when the young man heard these words, he went away sad, for he had great possessions. But Jesus said to His disciples, "Amen I say to you, with difficulty will a rich man enter the kingdom of heaven. And further I say to you it is easier for a camel to pass through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of heaven." The disciples, hearing this, were exceedingly astonished, and said, "Who then can be saved?" And looking upon them, Jesus said to them, "With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."
