

Fifth Sunday after Holy Cross Saints of the Day

Commemoration of our venerable Father JOANNICIUS THE GREAT, the Hermit of Mount Olympus, of the Holy Hieromartyr NICANDER, Bishop of Myra, and of HERMEUS the Priest

Our holy Father Joannicius the Great was born in 754 in Marycata in Bithynia, near the pool



of Apolloniada. His parents charged him in his youth with feeding a herd of pigs. His occupation made him enroll in the army. He showed himself to be a valliant soldier in all the campaigns against the Bulgarians. Affiliated with his parents in the Iconoclast heresy, he abjured the impious doctrine which he had professed for a while in ignorance, thanks to the exhortations of an old man. One day, seeing several of his companions fall in the course of a battle and upset by this spectacle, he deserted the army and withdrew to Mount Olympus in 795. Recognized by one of his old army companions, he fled and took refuge on a mountain of Lycia where, after a revelation, he became a monk at the monastery of Eristea in 806. He withdrew successively to several mountains and died in 846, at an old age, under the patriarchate of Saint Methodius whose elevation to the patriarchal see he had predicted. 1

BEING MELKITE - DID YOU KNOW? The Sign of the Cross is made by joining three fingers (thumb, index and middle) together; putting two fingers (ring and little) down on the palm and lifting the hand first to the forehead, then to the chest, then to the right shoulder, and then the left shoulder. The thumb and first two fingers held together represent the Holy Trinity: God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The ring finger and little finger signify the two natures of Christ: Human and Divine. In the Scriptures right generally represents good and left evil, and in the Creed the Son is said to sit at the right hand of the Father, thus the signing of the right shoulder first. ²



A READING from the Epistle of St. Paul to the Ephesians

BRETHREN, Christ is our peace. He it is who has made both [Jews and Gentiles] one, and has broken down the intervening wall of the enclosure, the enemy, in his flesh. He has voided the Law of commandments expressed in decrees, so that of the two he might create in himself one new man, and make peace, and reconcile both in one body to God through the cross, having destroyed their enmity within himself. And as he came, he announced the good tidings of peace to you who were far away, and of peace to those who were near: because through him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father. Therefore, you are now no longer strangers or foreigners, but citizens with the saints and members of God's household: you are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets (Cf.Is.28: 16) with Christ himself as the chief cornerstone. In him the whole structure is closely fitted together and grows into a temple holy in the Lord; in him you too are being built together into a dwelling place for God in the Spirit.
