


BEING MELKITE - DID YOU KNOW? We have our own, Eastern manner to enter a church. Upon entering and leaving the church, make the Sign of the Cross and say (thrice with metanies): O God, be propitious to me, a sinner, and have mercy on me! Before going to your place, it is customary to venerate the icons and light candles.

As Christians we ought to consider well when we enter the church that we are entering 'Heaven on earth': the same Divine Majesty which is in Heaven is also present in His church. On this account, a Christian must enter with humility, reverence, and the fear of God. ²



A READING from the Epistle of St. Paul to the Galatians (pg. 390)

BRETHREN, Abraham had two sons, the one by a slave-girl and the other by a free woman (Gn. 16:15; 21:2). And the son of the slave-girl was born according to the flesh, but the son of the free woman, in virtue of the promise. This is said by way of allegory.

For these are the two covenants, one indeed from Mount Sinai, bringing forth children that were to be bondage: this is Agar. Fro Sinai is a mountain in Arabia, which corresponds to the present Jerusalem, and is in slavery with her children. But that Jerusalem which is above is free, which is our mother. For it is written, Rejoice, you barren woman who do not bear; break forth and cry, you who do not travail: for many are the children of the desolate, more that of the one who has a husband (Is. 54:1).

GOSPEL of the Tenth Sunday after Holy Cross Luke 13:10-17 (Healing the Crippled Woman) At that time Jesus was teaching in one of their synagogues on the Sabbath. And behold, there was a woman who for eighteen years had had a sickness caused by a spirit; and she was bent over and utterly unable to look upwards. When Jesus saw her, he called her to him and said to her, "Woman, thou art delivered from thy infirmity." And he laid his hands upon her, and instantly she was made straight, and glorified God. But the ruler of the synagogue, indignant that Jesus had cured on the Sabbath, addressed the crowd, saying, "There are six days in which one ought to work; on these therefore come and be cured, and not on the Sabbath." But the Lord answered him and said, "Hypocrites! Does not each one of you on the Sabbath loose his ox or ass from the manger, and lead it forth to water? And this woman, daughter of Abraham as she is, whom Satan has bound, lo, for eighteen years, ought not she to be loosed from this bond on the Sabbath?" And as he said these things, all his adversaries were put to shame; and the entire crowd rejoiced at all the glorious things that were done by him.
