



Sunday of the Forefathers of Christ

On this day the Church commemorates the Holy Ancestors of Christ, and at the same time all the holy Patriarchs of the Old Testament who prefigured or foretold Christ: Adam the first Father, Enoch, Melchisedec, Abraham, the friend of God, Isaac, the fruit of the Promise, Jacob and the twelve patriarchs. Then those who lived under the Law: Moses Aaron, Josue, Samuel, David, and the Prophets: Isaias, Jeremias, Ezechiel, the twelve minor prophets, Elias, Eliseus, Zacharias, and John the Baptist, and finally the Virgin Mary, the intermediary between mankind and her divine Son.

Indeed, the Lord Jesus did not come to abolish the Law and the Prophets, but to redeem humanity which bemoaned the weight of evil since Adam, to realize the promise made to Abraham, to change the Law of fear into the Law of Love, to give resurrection and life to mankind. Troparion of Resurrection (Tone 5)

Let us, O faithful, praise and worship the word, coeternal with the Father and the Spirit, born of the Virgin for our Salvation, for He was pleased to be lifted in the flesh upon the cross, and to endure death, and to raise the dead by His glorious resurrection.

A READING from the Epistle of St. Paul to the Colossians

BRETHREN, when Christ, our life, appears, then you too shall appear in glory. Put to death whatever in your members is of the earth: immorality, uncleanness, lust, evil desire, covetousness, which is a form of idol-worship. Because of these passions, God's wrath comes upon the sons of disobedience and you yourselves once walked in them when they were your (way of) life. But now, you too put them all away; anger, wrath, malice, abusive language and foul-mouthed utterances. Do not lie to one another. Strip off the old man with his deeds and put on the new, one that is being renewed toward perfect knowledge according to his creator's image (Cf. Gn. 1:26). Here there is no Gentile and Jew, no circumcised and uncircumcised, no Barbarian and Scythian, no slave and freeman, but Christ is all things, and in all.

GOSPEL of the Sunday of the Forefathers (11th after HC) Luke 14: 16-24 (*The Great Feast*) The Lord told this parable, "A certain man gave a great supper, and he invited many. And he sent his servant at supper time to tell those invited to come, for everything is now ready. And they all with one accord began to excuse themselves. The first said to him, 'I have bought a farm, and I must go out and see it; I pray you hold me excused.' And another said, 'I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I am on my way to try them; I pray you hold me excused.' And another said, 'I have married a wife, and therefore I cannot come.' And the servant returned, and reported these things to his master. Then the master of the house became angry and said to his servant. 'Go out quickly into the streets and lanes of the city, and bring in here the poor, and the crippled, and the lame, and the blind.' And the servant said, 'Sir, your order has been carried out, and still there is room.' Then the master said to the servant, 'Go out into the highways and hedges, and make them come in, so that my house may be filled. For I tell you that none of those who were invited shall taste of my supper.' For many are called but few are chosen."

- 1. **Cash, Check or Credit Card:** In person, by mail (P.O. Box 231328 San Diego, CA 92193) or securely online at www.stjacobmelkite.org/donate.
- 2. Recurring EFT from your bank: Flexible amount / frequency. Contact Rami Maria for setup.
- 3. **Zelle:** All major banks participate in the Zelle payment platform allowing donations to be sent easily, on a one-time or recurring basis, to our email address: donate@stjacobmelkite.org.
- 4. Corporate / Foundation Giving: Please contact Rami Maria to inquire.
- 5. **Property:** Gifts such as a residential, vacation or commercial property, land, or tangible property such as works of art, jewelry, collections and other personal property may be given. Tax receipts based on assessed value will be provided.
