12th Sunday after Pentecost, The Holy Hieromartyr Irenaeus, & The Holy Martyr Lupus

Irenaeus was born in Smyrna around 120 AD and is thought to have been a disciple of Saint Polycarp, Bishop of Smyrna. Irenaeus went to Lyons in Gaul where he fought pagans and heretics, and is responsible for making Lyon a bastion of orthodoxy. He was martyred around the year 202 during the reign of Septimius Severus.

Lupus was born toward the conclusion of the 3rd century and was a follower and servant of the Great Martyr Demetrius of Thessalonica. He as an outspoken critic of paganism and worked many miracles. Eventually he was delivered to the authorities and beheaded early in the 4th century by order of Emperor Galerius.
