Fifth Sunday of Lent – Sunday of our Venerable Mother Mary of Egypt

St Mary of Egypt left home as a young girl and lived a notorious life of ill repute. Traveling widely, she fell in with a group of pilgrims on their way to venerate the True Cross in Jerusalem. Attempting to enter the church to view the Cross, an unseen force held her back. Viewing an icon of the Theotokos, Mary realized that her horrid life had been the reason she could not behold the Live-giving Tree inside the church. Vowing to reform her life if given the opportunity to view the Cross, her wish was granted; she venerated the Cross and then fled into the wilderness and lived a life of repentance for decades, with no human contact, save for a couple of visits by Abba Zosimas, who, by chance, happened upon her in the desert. Mary went to her heavenly repose shortly after receiving the Eucharist on Holy Thursday evening from Zosimas.

Great Lenten services: For Great Lent we will have services at Holy Angels on Wednesday at 6:00 pm and Friday at 7:30 pm. We will alternate Great Compline and the Pre-sanctified Liturgy on Wednesdays and celebrate the Akathist on Fridays. We hope you will join us. We will celebrate the Diving Liturgy of St John Chrysostom on Wednesday, 24 March, celebrating the feast of the Annunciation.

Troparion of the resurrection (1st tone)After the stone was sealed by the Jews * and the while the soldiers were watching Your spotless body, * You rose, O Savior, on the third day, * bestowing life to the world. * Therefore, the heavenly powers cried out to You, O Giver of life: *"Glory to Your resurrection, O Christ! * Glory to Your kingdom! * Glory to Your economy, * O You Who alone are the lover of mankind!"

Troparion of our Mother Mary of Egypt (8th tone)

In you, O Mother Mary, was restored the likeness of God, for you carried your cross and followed Christ. taught by your deeds how to spurn the body, for it passes away and how to value the soul, for it is immortal. Wherefore your soul is forever in happiness with the angels.

Troparion of St. Jacob, Brother of the Lord (Tone 4) As a disciple of the Lord, you received the Gospel, O holy Jacob. As a martyr, you displayed unyielding will. As a brother of God, you have special power with Him. As a hierarch, you have the right of intercession. Intercede, therefore, with Christ God that he may save our souls.

Kondakion of the Annunciation

Triumphant leader to you belongs our prize of victory! And since you saved us from adversity, we offer you our thanks. We are your people O Theotokos! So, as you have that invincible power, continue to deliver us from danger that we may cry out to you Hail, O Virgin and bride ever pure.

Reading from the Epistle of St. Paul to the Hebrews BRETHREN, when Christ appeared as the high priest of the good things to come (Cf.Lv.16: 14; 19: 4), he entered once for all through the greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made by hands (that is, not as a part of the present creation), nor again by virtue of blood of goats and calves, but by virtue of his own blood, into the sanctuary, having obtained eternal redemption. Gospel: 5th Sunday of Lent, Mark 10: 32-45 (The greatest in the Kingdom)

At that time Jesus took the Twelve, and began to tell them what would happen to him, saying, "Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and the Son of Man will be betrayed to the chief priests and the Scribes; and they will condemn him to death, and will deliver him to the Gentiles; and they will mock him, and spit upon him and scourge him, and put him to death; and on the third day he will rise again." And James and John, the sons of Zebedee, came to him, saying, "Master, we want thee to do for us whatever we ask." But he said to them, "What do you want me to do for you?" And they said, "Grant to us that we may sit, one at thy right hand and the other at thy left hand, in thy glory." But Jesus said to them,

"You do not know what you are asking for. Can you drink of the cup of which I drink, or be baptized with the baptism with which I am to be baptized?" And they said to him, "We can." And Jesus said to them "Of the cup that I drink, you shall drink; and with the baptism with which I am to be baptized, you shall be baptized; but as for sitting at my right hand or at my left, that is not mine to give, but it belongs to those for whom it has been prepared." And when the ten heard this, they were at first indignant at James and John. But Jesus called them and said to them, "You know that those who are regarded as rulers among the Gentiles I lord it over them, and their great men exercise authority over them. But it is not so among you. On the contrary, whoever wishes to become great shall be your servant; and whoever wishes to be first among you shall be the slave of all; for the Son of Man also has not come to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."
