Today marks the beginning of the **Dormition Fast**, the period preparing us for the Dormition of the Mother of God. May our efforts during these two weeks help us celebrate the Falling Asleep in Christ God of His beloved Mother.

We also observe the **Procession of the Most Holy, Precious, and Life-Giving Cross**. During August in ancient Constantinople, there seemed to be a spike in various diseases and illnesses. To purify the city and its residents, the Cross would be taken from its place of repose in the emperor's treasure house, and processed through the city and, for a time, be venerated in Hagia Sophia. May the power of this life-giving wood bring us deliverance form all manner of illnesses and diseases, especially as the COVID pandemic continues to afflict us.

Looking ahead: this week we celebrate the **Transfiguration of our Lord**. We will have joint vespers with Holy Angels on Thursday evening at 6:00 pm.
