#### **Twelfth Sunday After the Holy Cross**

الاحد الثاني عشر بعد الصليب

Today we celebrate St Paul of Thebes, born ca. 227 in Egypt. Saint Paul, first among hermits, he fled in 250 into the wilderness because of the Decian persecutions. He was a hermit for over 90 years and reposed in the Lord at the age of 114. He was buried by St Anthony the Great who, inspired by God, made a journey to visit Paul a few days before the latter's death.

We also commemorate St John the Hut Dweller. St John hailed from a prominent family in Constantinople; his father was a senator, Eutropius, and his mother was Theodora. As a young teenager he left home and entered the monastery. After several years, longing for home, he returned under the guise of a beggar and lived in a small hut outside his parents' home, suffering abuse at the hands of those who had formerly been his servants. Shortly before his death, he revealed himself to his parents then reposed in the Lord around the year 450.
