عيد الصعود - Feast of the Ascension

For forty days after Pascha, the risen Lord had appeared to the disciples, eating and drinking with them, telling them many things, giving them their Great Commission: "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the holy Spirit, reaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age" (Mt 18:19-20). Ultimately, he returned to His Father in heaven, as was seated at God's right hand. "The Ascension of Christ shows the last stage in God's plan for mankind: total union with Himself upon one's departure from the world. According to V. Rev. George Florovsky, 'In the Ascension resides the meaning and the fullness of Christ's Resurrection....and with Christ, man's nature ascends also.'" <https://orthodoxwiki.org/Ascension>

- 1) Great is the Lord and wholly to be praised in the city of our God, on His holy mountain
O Son of God Who ascended in glory to heaven, save us who sing to You: Alleluia.
- 2) Mount Sion, the recesses of the North, is the City of the Great King.
- 3) God is with her castles: renowned is He as a stronghold.

Entrance hymn: God ascended amid shouts of joy, the Lord amid trumpet blasts. **O Son of God, Who ascended in glory to heaven, save us who sing to You: Alleluia!**

Troparion of the Ascension (4th Tone) – 3x

You ascended in glory, O Christ our God, and gladdened Your disciples by the promise of the Holy Spirit. Through Your blessing they were confirmed in their belief that You are the Son of God, the Redeemer of the world.

Kondakion of the Ascension,

After fulfilling for us Your plan of redemption and joining the things of earth with those of heaven, You gloriously ascended O Christ our God without abandoning us, but remained with us forever and proclaimed to those who love You: "Behold, I am with you: no one has power against you."

READING from the Acts of the Apostles:

In the preceding book, Theophilus, I was concerned with everything Jesus did and taught from the beginning, until the day He was taken up, after giving commandments through the Holy Spirit to the apostles He had chosen. To them also He showed himself alive after His passion by many proofs, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about God's kingdom. And while eating with them, He told them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait for the Father's promise, "of which you have heard," He said, "by My mouth. For while John baptized with water, you shall be

baptized in the Holy Spirit within a few days." Now, those gathered there questioned Him, asking, "Lord, is it now that You will restore the kingdom to Israel?" But He answered them, "It is not for you to know the times or the proper moments the Father has set by His own authority. But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in Judea and Samaria, and even to the very ends of the earth." And when He had said this, while they were looking on, He rose up, and a cloud hid Him from their eyes. And as they kept looking at the sky while He went, behold, two men stood by them in white garments and said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking up at the sky? This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven will come in the same way as you have seen Him going up to heaven." Then they returned to Jerusalem from the mountain called Olive Grove which is near Jerusalem, a Sabbath day's journey.

Gospel of the Feast of Ascension: Luke 24:36-53, p.41
THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO ST. LUKE THE EVANGELIST:

At that time, after His resurrection, Jesus stood in the midst of His disciples and said to them, "Peace to you!" But they were startled and panic-stricken, and thought they were seeing a ghost. And He asked them, "Why are you disturbed, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? See My hands and feet, that it is I myself. Feel Me and see; for a ghost does not have flesh and bones, as you see I have." And having said this, He showed them His hands and His feet. But as joy left them disbelieving, and they marveled, He said, "Have you anything here to eat?" And they offered Him a piece of broiled fish and a honeycomb. And taking it, He ate it before them. And He said to them, "These are the words I spoke to you while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled that are written in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms concerning Me." Then He opened their minds, that they might understand the Scriptures. And He said to them, "Thus it is written; and thus, the Christ should suffer, and should rise again from the dead on the third day; and repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. And you yourselves are witnesses to these things. And I send forth upon you the promise of My Father. But wait here in the city until you are clothed with power from on high." Now He led them out towards Bethany, and He lifted up His hands and blessed them. And it came to pass as He blessed them, that He parted from them and was carried up into heaven. And they worshipped Him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy. And they were continually in the temple, praising and blessing God. Amen.
