VESPERS

At "O Lord, to You I call..."

Stichera for Thursday (Tone 1)

- 6. O glorious Apostles of Christ, disciples called by our God, you are teachers of the whole world! Having found the Lord, the Mediator between God and men, you were united to Him and clearly proclaimed Him throughout the world as true God and true Man.
- 5. O most wise Apostles of Christ, by your prayers obtain wisdom of heart for me. You are truly initiates and dispensers of Wisdom who shed the light of the Paraclete. In that Fire, burn out the corruption from my heart; make me worthy to sing of you and call you blessed.
- 4. O Apostles, you have seen the Word of God! Enlighten my soul which has been darkened by the passions, for your divine teachings have illumined the very limits of the universe and drive out the darkness of idolatry. Intercede now that our souls be given peace and great mercy.

For Charitina (Tone 4)

3. Named for joy, you joyously departed to the bridal chamber of Heaven, where you found the life you desired, since you bravely endured the most painful torments when they tore out all your nails and teeth, O victorious Charitina, virgin and martyr of many struggles.

When you generously suffered the pulling out of your nails, you pulled out the frightening rumblings of error. When they cast you into the depths of the sea, you drowned all the perversity of the enemy.
- After your blessed end, when you were cast into the sea, O glorious martyr Charitina, your father recovered your body. Filled with admiration, he cried out, "O sacred child, beloved daughter, the torments of martyrdom have filled you with beauty! You have fulfilled the promise of your name, which prefigured the grace of God for you."

APOSTICHA (Tone 1)

1. The harp of the Apostles is filled with sweet harmonious music as it is played by the Holy Spirit. It banished the mysteries and worship inspired by demons. As it sang of the one and only Lord, it delivered the people from the error of idolatry, teaching them to bow down in worship before the consubstantial Trinity.

- v. To You I have lifted up my eyes, to You who live in heaven. Behold: the eyes of the servants are turned to the hands of their masters, and the eyes of the maid-servants to the hands of their mistresses; thus do our eyes watch the Lord our God until He takes pity on us.
- 2. Let us praise with one accord the Apostles Peter and Paul, Luke, Matthew, Mark and John, Andrew, Thomas, Bartholomew, James, Philip and Simon. Let us direct our hymns of praise to the whole company of the Disciples!
- v. Have mercy on us, O Lord, have mercy on us, for we have been filled with shame: our soul has been filled to overflowing. May scorn befall detractors, and humiliation come to the proud.
- 3. O martyrs worthy of all praise, although the earth did not conceal your bodies in burial, heaven has welcomed you. The gates of Paradise were opened to you, and there you rejoice in the Tree of Life. Intercede with Christ that He grant our souls peace and great mercy!
