Today we will observe the great feast of the Transfiguration of Our Lord. "Upon Mount Tabor, Jesus revealed to his disciples a heavenly mystery. These are the divine wonders we celebrate today; this is the saving revelation given us upon the mountain; this is the festival of Christ that has drawn us here. Let us listen, then, to the sacred voice of God so compellingly calling us from on high, from the summit of the mountain, so that with the Lord's chosen disciples we may penetrate the deep meaning of these holy mysteries, so far beyond our capacity to express." From a sermon on the Transfiguration by Bishop Anastasius of Sinai.
