Beginning of the Induction; St. Simeon the Stylite; Synaxis of the Theotokos 15th Sunday after Pentecost

Today is **THE BEGINNING OF THE CHURCH YEAR, OR THE BEGINNING OF THE INDICTION**. The First Ecumenical Council [Nicaea, 325] decreed that the Church year should begin on September 1. The month of September was, for the Hebrews, the beginning of the civil year (Exodus 23:16), the month of gathering the harvest and of the offering of thanks to God. It was on this feast that the Lord Jesus entered the synagogue in Nazareth (Luke 4:16-21), opened the book of the Prophet Isaiah and read the words: *The Spirit of the Lord God is upon Me; because the Lord hath anointed Me to preach good tidings unto the meek; He hath sent Me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound; to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn (Isaiah 61:1-2). The month of September is also important in the history of Christianity, because Emperor Constantine the Great was victorious over Maxentius, the enemy of the Christian Faith, in September. Following this victory, Constantine granted freedom of confession to the Christian Faith throughout the Roman Empire. For a long time, the civil year in the Christian world followed the Church year, with its beginning on September 1. The civil year was later changed, and its beginning transferred to January 1. This occurred first in Western Europe, and later in Russia, under Peter the Great.*

Troparion of the Resurrection: (Tone 6)

The angelic powers were around Your tomb, and the guards became as dead; and Mary stood at the tomb, seeking Your spotless body. Then You despoiled Hades without being tried by it and You met the Virgin, O Bestower of life. O Lord, who rose from the dead, glory to You!

Troparion of the New Year: (Tone 2)

Maker of the Universe, O Lord who alone have power over seasons and times: bless this year with Your bounty, preserve our country in safety and keep Your people in peace, through the prayers of the Mother of God, and save us.

Troparion of the Theotokos: (Tone 7)

Hail O Woman full of grace, ever-virgin Mother of God, harbor and protectress of the human kind: the Savior of the universe received flesh from you, for you are the only one to be both mother and virgin, forever blessed, forever glorified. Intercede with Christ God that He may grant peace to the whole inhabited earth.

Troparion of St. Simeon Stylite: (Tone 1)

A pillar of endurance, you competed with the Forefathers; Job in his struggles, Joseph in his temptations, and the bodiless Angels though you were in the body. Our Holy Father Simeon, intercede with Christ God for the salvations of our souls!

Troparion of St. Jacob, Brother of the Lord: (Tone 4)

As a disciple of the Lord, you received the Gospel, O holy Jacob. As a martyr, you displayed unyielding will. As a brother of God, you have special power with Him. As a hierarch, you have the right of intercession. Intercede, therefore, with Christ God that he may save our souls.

O Creator and Master of time and eternity, super substantial God of all, O Merciful One: bless the course of this year, and in Your boundless mercy, save all those who worship You our one and only Master and who cry out to You in fear: "O Savior, grant a happy year to all mankind!"

Epistle: For the New Year (1 Tim 2: 1-7)

PROKIMENON: Great is our Lord, and mighty in power.

To His wisdom, there is no limit.

Stichon: Praise the Lord, for the Lord is good; sing to His name, for it is excellent.

READING from the First Epistle of St. Paul to Timothy My dear son Timothy, I urge first of all those supplications, prayers, intercessions and thanksgivings be made for all men; for kings and for all in high positions, that we may lead a quiet and peaceful life in all piety and worthy behavior. This is good and agreeable in the sight of God our Savior, Who wishes all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth (Cf. Ez. 18: 23). For there is one God, and one Mediator between God and men, Himself a man, Christ Jesus, Who gave Himself up as a ransom for all, bearing witness in His own time. To this I have been appointed a preacher and an apostle (I tell the truth, I do not lie), a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and truth.

And after He opened the volume, He found the place where it was written, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me; because He has anointed Me; to bring good news to the poor He has sent Me, to proclaim to the captives release, and sight to the blind; to set at liberty the oppressed, to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord." And closing the volume, He gave it back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all in the synagogue were upon Him. But He began to say to them, "Today this Scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing." And all bore Him witness, and marveled at the words of grace that came from His mouth.
