# Commemoration of the Holy Prophet Zecheriah, the Father of the Forerunner

## **VESPERS**

Stichera for the Apostles (Tone 6)

- 6. Having received the heavenly power of the Paraclete, the Apostles of Christ drove back the hordes of the enemy. They put the wise to shame and triumphed over kings, though they were unskilled and unlettered, fighting without shields or weapons, armed only with the Gospel. By the word of truth, they worked wonders and brought the nations to obedience to Christ; and they now boldly intercede on behalf of our souls.
- 5. For love of You, the glorious Apostles renounced themselves and followed after You wholeheartedly. Taking up their cross in Your footsteps, in obedience to Your command, they abandoned the earth and received Heaven as their inheritance, bringing the nations to knowledge of You, O Lord. Having become Your companions forever, they now boldly intercede on behalf of our souls.
- 4. Having spent my whole life in negligence, I have come to its end without bearing any fruit, carrying only the painful burden of my evil deeds, O God of all goodness. O Lover of Mankind, blot them out by the power of Your love. Grant me compunction and a saving conversion at the prayers of Your Apostles, O my God, whom I offer to You as intercessors together with the Woman who gave You birth.

## For Zecheriah (Tone 4)

- 3. Clothed in your holy vestments and your anointing, you ministered before God like an angel, O Zecheriah, prophet all worthy of our praise, serving as a mediator between creatures and their Creator. You openly received the revelation of the Holy Spirit; thus we call you blessed as we celebrate your holy feast today, singing the glory of the Savior.
- 2. O Zecheriah, divinely inspired Prophet, you beheld the Son, coeternal to the Father, as an Infant born of the Virgin. Of your own son, you clearly foretold, "You shall be the prophet preparing the way for God!" With him, we call you blessed, O God-bearer filled with eternal joy, and we reverently celebrate your feast.
- 1. the incarnate Temple, the living were dwelling-place of the Holy Spirit, O illustrious Prophet. As you approached your God with a pure heart in the of the Temple, vou ended vour slaughtered unjustly in martyrdom, O wondrous Zecheriah. Thus you were lifted up to the heavenly Temple where, with the price of your blood, you beg forgiveness for the faithful who venerate you.

#### **APOSTICHA** (Tone 8)

1. O wonder which fills us with amazement! The Archangel who stands before God in the heights of Heaven comes to the holy servant Zecheriah to announce the conception of the Forerunner, born of a barren woman in her old age. Ineffable is Your Providence, O Lord! By it, save our souls, O compassionate Christ!

All: Blessed be the Lord, the God of Israel; He has come to His people and set them free.

2. O wonder which fills us with amazement! The silencing of the Old Testament and the announcement of the New are both clearly prophesied by the muteness of Zecheriah. Passing through the fulfillment of the Law in silence, he clearly manifests the light of grace. Wise is Your Providence, O Lord! By it, guard us, O almighty Lover of Mankind!

All: You, my child, shall be called the Prophet of the Most High.

3. O wonder which fills us with amazement! Zecheriah is seen bearing a triple crown, O Lord, because of his fidelity as a priest, his excellence as a martyr, and his mission as a prophet announcing Your coming. Immeasurable is the richness of Your gifts! By them, make us worthy of Your Kingdom, O Christ, our Beloved!
