Stichera for Hosea (Tone 1)

- 6. He who proceeds from the Father, the Holy Spirit, through your mouth set the future coming of Christ in these last times, to renew the creation. We who now see your predictions fulfilled, glorify your memory, O Hosea, prophet of God.
- 5. Our nature was once prostituted in spirit, far from You, O Lover of Mankind. You espoused it, to save it from dishonor, as You united it to Yourself in an ineffable and indissoluble manner. Your prophet Hosea, as a symbol of this union, took to wife a prostitute long ago, and he made her pass from adultery to chastity.
- 4. O inspired prophet Hosea who now see your predictions fulfilled by grace, intercede before the God of all, for all those who celebrate your memory with faith. Ask for them the remission of sins, peace and amendment of life.

For Andrew (Tone 4)

3. Attached to the Lord from your youth, you ran your race to a good end. Armed with the cross, O blessed Andrew, you put your hand to the plow of the commandments of the Lord, as it is written. Entreat Him to save from danger and all evil the faithful who celebrate your holy memory.

- 2. Having become a precious stone by faith, you were not broken by blows, O blessed Andrew. Rolled over in the ground, you made straight the way of faith, by which the journey becomes easy. You cast down, like a rotted pedestal, the insignificant renown of the sinful emperor.
- 1. Nourished by the teachings of the Apostles and Fathers, O blessed one, you venerated the visible features of the incarnate God portrayed by the sacred symbols and holy icons representing Him. You struggled for His sake, O holy Andrew, and showed yourself to be truly a master of piety and treasure of the martyrs.

O holy martyrs, you were living sacrifices, spiritual holocausts, victims pleasing to the Lord, sheep who know their divine Master and are known by Him whose fold is inaccessible to the ravaging wolves. Intercede with the Good Shepherd that we, too, may be nourished with you beside the still waters.
- All: Glory to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, now and forever and to the ages of ages. Amen.
