APOSTICHA (Tone 4)

1. Let us bow down before the honorable chains by which the bondage of the passions was broken. They were sanctified by the ineffable gifts of Peter indeed, and receive from him a stream of continuous grace. Like him, they loosen sins; and by a gift of God, they grant deliverance from the most cruel afflictions.

All: Their voice has gone forth over the whole world, and their words to the limits of the universe.

2. Illustrious Cephas, your chains are as radiant as a heavenly cord, lifting us up from earth to the height of the gates of Heaven; and they bring us close to you in faith, O illustrious key-bearer. O Apostle worthy of admiration, who hold in your hands the keys of the kingdom: in your compassion, open to us the gates of salvation.

All: The heavens declare the glory of God and the firmament shows forth the work of His hands.

3. In choir with mankind, the angels in Heaven intone your praises today, O Peter. For when an angel entered and touched your side, accompanying you past the guard, you left the chains to your jailers. O holy Apostle, obtain for us the joy of lessening our endless chains of sins.
